VOLVO ENDS ONLINE BOOKING

VOLVO Car Malaysia has closed online booking for the 2022 XC40 Recharge Pure Electric (RPE) due to the overwhelming response.

It will only begin taking orders again for the 2023 model, with details to be announced later.

However, booking for the test drive is still available via the brand's official website.

Volvo Car Malaysia's first locally assembled fully electric vehicle (EV) has received more than 400 orders since its launch in March, with 120 units delivered to their owners.

"This is a stepping stone to our all-electric journey," said Volvo Car Malaysia managing

director Charles Frump.

"Just a few months ago, we launched our first fully electric car and announced the local assembly of EVs. We have started delivery to our customers in April, providing them with a vehicle that allows them the freedom to move in a personal, sustainable and safe way," he added.

Based on the XC40 compact premium sport utility vehicle

model, the XC40 RPE is priced at RM262,659.75 and features a fully electric all-wheel-drive powertrain that offers a range of up to 418km.

It is available in the five colour options of Black Stone, Crystal White Pearl, Denim Blue, Glacier Silver and Sage Green.

It comes with a five-year vehicle warranty, eight-year high-voltage battery warranty and a five-year roadside assistance.



Booking for the test drive is still available.



Orders will only resume when details of the 2023 model are announced.
